Walton (Berkswich) Village Hall Risk Assessment

There is no legal requirement for the Management Committee to comply with the 1974 Health and Safety at Work Act as we do not employ any staff. However, we recognise that we have a duty of care towards the users of our premises and subcontractors conducting new works and maintenance.

We have therefore undertaken a risk assessment of the various areas of the Hall and curtilage. The outcome of the review has been to demonstrate how the Management Committee fulfils these obligations. It shall be noted that each User Organisation is required to abide by the Terms and Conditions (T's & C's) published on the Walton (Berkswich) Village Hall (WVH) website.
